VICTIM(S): 18 year old resident of the home
SUSPECT(S): Three to four black males unknown height or weight.

DETAILS:

The Brown Deer Police Department is continuing the November 10, 2007 investigation of the shooting inside the residence at 4619 West Woodale Avenue. The victim in the case is making a full recovery and has been released from the hospital. The investigation into the shooting is continuing. Evidence has been sent to the Wisconsin Crime Lab and we are waiting for the results.

Based on some of the evidence found at the scene, the Brown Deer Police Department did seek and obtain a search warrant for the residence. The search warrant revealed evidence suggesting drug distribution. This information was presented to the U.S. Attorney's Office. The U.S. Attorney's office then indicted resident John E. Brown Sr. for Conspiracy to Distribute Cocaine.

The Brown Deer Police Department will continue to follow up on all leads.
