The Village of Brown Deer is announcing a change in its recycling service. The Village is implementing single stream collection with a 96 gallon recycling cart. This cart replaces the existing 18 gallon bin. Recyclables will be collected bi-weekly, with the first collection the week of April 7th by the Village's contractor Veolia Environmental Services. Residents are being provided a calendar that shows the weeks of recycling and yard waste collections for 2008.

The change will take place the week of March 31st through April 4th. Residents are requested to place all their recycling bins and recyclables out as usual. The bins will be collected with the recyclables on collection day. The new recycling cart will be distributed the next day, except that Friday's route will be delivered ahead of time on Monday, March 31st. The old recycling bins will be used to make new refuse and recycling carts by the manufacturer, Cascade Engineering.

In each cart, in a bag hung on a hook on the lid, will be the Village's Refuse/Recycling Rules and Guidelines brochure for the residents. Also included are materials on Household Hazardous Waste disposal, the Medicine Collection Day of April 19th, and material on refuse reduction, reuse, and recycling.
