

A Resolution Authorizing the Village Manager
to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding in Support
of the Southeastern Wisconsin Watersheds Trust (SWWT)

Resolution No. 08-16

WHEREAS, members of the Milwaukee County Intergovernmental Cooperation Council, which is comprised of the mayors and village presidents of the municipalities within Milwaukee County and the County Executive of Milwaukee County, reviewed and is encouraging municipalities to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding; and,

WHEREAS, a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is made and entered into among the members of the Southeastern Wisconsin Watersheds Trust (SWWT); and,

WHEREAS, Southeastern Wisconsin Watershed Trust is a new partnership created from the Regional Water Quality Management Plan Update completed and approved in 2007; and,


WHEREAS, the Memorandum of Understanding creates a voluntary, non-taxing partnership of independent units of government, special purpose districts, agencies, organizations and members at large that share common goals and have come together to achieve these goals through coordinated collaboration and cooperation within the Greater Milwaukee Watersheds; and,


WHEREAS, the mission of the Southeastern Wisconsin Watersheds Trust (SWWT) is a collaborative effort to achieve healthy and sustainable water resources throughout the Greater Milwaukee Watersheds; and,

WHEREAS, the Village of Brown Deer Board of Trustees support the mission of the Southeastern Wisconsin Watersheds Trust (SWWT).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Village of Brown Deer Board of Trustees authorize the Village Manager is authorized and directed to sign the Southeastern Wisconsin Watersheds Trust's Memorandum of Understanding and otherwise support activities that improve receiving water resources consistent with the Southeastern Wisconsin Regional Planning Commission's (SEWRPC) Regional Water Quality Management Plan Update (RWQMPU).
