

Resolution Approving Widening of Highway,  
Authorizing Jurisdictional Offer, and Ordering  
the Relocation of Current Highway Boundaries

Resolution No. 08-19

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Brown Deer has approved redevelopment in certain areas of the Village, including the intersection of 60<sup>th</sup> Street and Brown Deer Road; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village Board is working in conjunction with the State of Wisconsin Department of Transportation, and has determined that it is in need of additional right of way to incorporate a revised turning radius on the east side of 60<sup>th</sup> Street; and


**WHEREAS**, it will be necessary to relocate the boundary of certain adjacent real estate in order to accommodate the reconstruction of the aforescribed intersection; and

**WHEREAS**, the area to be obtained, as well as the subject parcel from which the area to be obtained, are depicted upon the attached Exhibit A incorporated herein;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, under authority of Sec. 66.1031 and Sec. 32.05 of the Wisconsin States, as follows:

1. The Village Board finds the reconstruction of the intersection of 60<sup>th</sup> and Brown Deer as depicted on Exhibit A and herein aforescribed, to be in the public interest.
2. The Village Board determines and orders that the boundary of the adjacent parcel be relocated, and property obtained, for road purposes as depicted on Exhibit A.
3. Village staff is directed to submit a Jurisdictional Offer, in conformance with Sec. 32.05 of the Wisconsin Statutes, and in a form as attached hereto, incorporated herein, and herein approved, to the owner of the subject parcel, Mr. John Josephitis, in the amount of \$700.00, along with accompanying appraisal documentation determining and setting such value.
4. The Village Board further authorizes Village staff to offer to pay the cost of an appraisal by Mr. John Josephitis for the subject area to be acquired.
