
WHEREAS, Milwaukee County has notified the Village of Brown Deer of an anticipated Spring Primary Election on Tuesday, February 17, 2009, for the office of State Superintendent of Public Instruction and Milwaukee County Circuit Court, Branch 15; and,

WHEREAS, the consolidation of polling places will allow the Village of Brown Deer to manage the election process in a more effective and efficient manner.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Village Board of Trustees of the Village of Brown Deer, Milwaukee County, Wisconsin, that pursuant to Wisconsin Statute 5.15(6)(b) and 5.25(3), that for the February 17, 2009 Spring Primary Election, there will be one common polling place and reporting unit in the Village for all nine (9) wards, that being the Village Hall, 4800 West Green Brook Drive.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this Resolution be forwarded to the Milwaukee County Election Commission and that adequate notices and publicity be provided throughout the Village.
