

RECYCLING BASICS

For residential households in the Village, curbside recycling collection takes place every other week on the same day as garbage collection. If you do not know what your collection day is, contact Public Works at (414)357-0120. Each household is provided with one recycling cart. If you have excess recycling you may bring it to the Brown Deer Recycling Center (details provided below).

HOLIDAY COLLECTION SCHEDULE

During holiday weeks, the garbage/recycling/yard waste collection schedule will be slightly changed as follows:

- ❑ During the week of Jan. 1st, Friday collections are shifted forward one day to Saturday.
- ❑ During the weeks of May 31st and September 6th, the collections (Mon.-Fri.) are shifted forward one day (Tues.-Sat.).
- ❑ During the week of July 5th, collections (Mon.-Fri.) are shifted forward one day (Tues.-Sat.).
- ❑ During the week of November 22nd Thursday and Friday collections are shifted forward one day to Friday and Saturday.
- ❑ During the week of December 20th and 27th collections will run as usual.

Gates Close **promptly** at 6 and 8 P.M. respectively.
Please time your drop-offs so that you will be finished unloading **prior to closing time**.

During times of adverse weather the Recycling Center may close early. When placing materials at the Recycling Center, please follow the Attendant's directions. **DO NOT** leave materials at the Recycling Center when the Center is closed – citations may be issued.

SPECIAL PICK UPS

Any items outside of your trash and recycling carts require a special pick up. Special pick ups are arranged and paid for by the resident directly with the waste hauler. Please contact Veolia Environmental Services (262)679-0860 to arrange for a special pick up.

If you are purchasing new appliances and have an old appliance to dispose of, it may be less costly to have the company delivering your new appliance remove the old one.

CART REPLACEMENT

If your village provided trash or recycling cart is damaged or lost, please contact the Department of Public Works (414)357-0120 to request a new one. There is no charge for carts damaged by the Village's Contractor or due to normal wear and tear.

YARD WASTE COLLECTION

- Yard waste and leaves shall be placed in one or more sealed paper yard waste bags, or 30 gallon containers, clearly marked "Yard Waste," with a tight fitting cover. **Do not seal with duct tape as it does not decompose.**
- Brush placed at the curbside shall be bundled and tied in lengths no longer than FIVE (5) feet with cut ends in the same direction, and weighing no more than 50 lbs.
- Any trunks or branches in excess of 6 inches in diameter shall be taken to the recycling center (or have your tree contractor be responsible for removing the material).
- Yard waste can also be taken to the Recycling Center during open hours **ONLY**. Brush **DOES NOT** have to be bundled when taken to the Recycling Center.
- Green grass clippings are **NOT** accepted curbside or at the recycling center. Consider mulching or composting.

YARD WASTE SHOULD ONLY BE PLACED CURBSIDE DURING DESIGNATED COLLECTION WEEKS.

Do not stockpile yard waste at the road as it is a violation of Village Code.
