

Special Collections Policy

Per Section 6-30.10 Special Services the Village Board has the authority to establish reasonable rules, regulations and fees for the collection and disposal of waste that is not collectable through the regular Domestic Waste collection as defined by the current contract. This does not apply to recyclables and yard/garden waste.

The schedule of fees shall be based upon the Refuse and Recycling Contract costs for the life of the contract. This schedule shall be effective January 1, 2009 and adjusted yearly by the Village Board.

Basic Special Pickup - 800 lbs. or 4 cyd. – bagged small items (12 yard size plastic bags)	\$50.00
Furniture – couch, loveseat, dining set, bookcase, entertainment unit, mattress/box spring, etc.	\$50.00
Air Conditioner Units – central, window; Dehumidifiers	\$50.00
Refrigerators, Freezers	\$50.00
Microwave Ovens	\$50.00
Electrical appliances/fixtures, trash compactors	\$50.00
Clothes Washer/Dryer, Dishwashers	\$50.00
Ranges/stoves/ovens	\$50.00
Plumbing Fixtures – sinks, tubs, commodes, water softeners	\$50.00
Furnaces, boilers, water heaters	\$50.00
Grouped items exceeding	<1000 lbs., 6 cyd. \$100.00
Basic Service	<1200 lbs., 8 cyd. \$150.00
	<1400 lbs., 10 cyd. \$200.00
Exceeding 1400 lbs., 10 cyd.	No pick-up
Construction/Demolition waste/rubble	No pick-up
Tires, auto or other batteries	No pick-up

Special Collection Fees shall be prepaid by the property owner or occupant to Village's contractor by credit card (preferred) or check. Failure to pay the fees within 30 days of the pickup shall initiate a penalty of double the fee and assessment on the property tax. The delinquent owner/occupant shall be placed on a list for full prepayment prior to any further service. Refunds shall not be given if materials were not set out or scavenged prior to the scheduled service and service was not canceled by owner/occupant. The above penalty may be in lieu of or in addition to the penalties set forth in Section 6-30.14 Penalty of the Village Code.

* The above fees are based upon: Contract costs, disposal costs and historical refuse tonnage per residence and a 15% administration fee for the program.
