TYPE OF CASE: Retail Theft, Car vs. Pedestrian Injury Crash

INJURIES: Pedestrian – non-life threatening injuries

PLACE OF OCCURRENCE: 9000 block of N. Green Bay Rd.

DETAILS:

On January 10, 2012 at 6:25 pm, Brown Deer Police Officers were dispatched to a report of a retail theft in progress at Kohl's Department Store, 9060 North Green Bay Road. The 17-year old female suspect was fleeing the scene on foot and running from the loss prevention officer. While running, the suspect was struck by a slow moving vehicle traveling northbound on North Green Bay Road. After being struck by the vehicle, the suspect continued to run westbound across North Green Bay Road and into the field by Fox 6, 9001 N. Green Bay Rd.

Upon officers' arrival, the suspect stopped running and was taken into custody. The North Shore Fire Department responded, treated the suspect for non-life threatening injuries, and transported her to a local hospital.

The vehicle that struck the suspect remained on scene. The investigation indicates that the driver, a 55-year old female from Brookfield, was driving her gray 2007 Toyota Corolla northbound on North Green Bay Road. The suspect ran westbound across North Green Bay Road in front of the vehicle.

The driver of the vehicle did not see the pedestrian and struck her in the roadway. The vehicle sustained minor damage and the driver was not injured. The driver was not issued any citations.

A State Crash Report will be submitted upon completion of the investigation as well as a report for the retail theft from Kohl's Department Store.
