DETAILS:

On Tuesday, January 31, 2012, at approximately 10:03 AM, the Brown Deer Police Department was notified by the Mequon Police Department that a shooting victim was at St. Mary's Ozaukee Hospital. The victim, a 24 year-old Brown Deer resident, suffered from a single gun shot wound to his leg/pelvic area. As a precaution, he was taken by Flight for Life to Froedtert Hospital to be treated for his injury. The suspect identified as the shooter in this incident is a 20 year-old relative of the victim and also a resident of Brown Deer.

Brown Deer officers continued to investigate this incident on February 1, 2012. The victim is currently in stable condition and remains under medical care at Froedtert Hospital.

The suspect was booked and transported to the Milwaukee County Criminal Justice Facility. We anticipate a review of the charge(s) against the suspect by Friday, February 3, 2012.
