DETAILS:

On Sunday, 6/28/2009, at approximately 6:41p.m. the Brown Deer Police Department responded with the North Shore Fire Department to the Brown Deer Village Pond for a report of a chemical spill. A Village Pond employee reported that a chemical used to balance the pH in the Village Pond had spilled inside of their chemical building. Upon arrival, officers and the North Shore Fire Department secured the area. The Village Pond was closed at the time of the incident, but employees were on scene. No employees were injured as a result of the spill. The chemical did not enter the Village Pond or contaminate any other areas.

The Regional Hazardous Materials Team responded to assist the North Shore Fire Department. The chemical was neutralized and disposed of consistent with hazardous materials protocol.
