Noteworthy Calls for the Day

Warrant – 9000blk N Bethanne Dr

An officer determined that the registered owner of a vehicle parked in the area had a temporary felony warrant through the Milwaukee Police Department for a Domestic Violence related incident. Officers made contact at the residence where the vehicle was parked and a 28 year old Milwaukee male was arrested for the warrant. He was conveyed the station, booked, and turned over to the Milwaukee Police Department. A report was filed.

Missing Juvenile – 7700blk N Sherman Blvd

A 33 year old Milwaukee female reported that her 15 year old daughter has been missing since 11/04/16. The juvenile was entered as missing and a report was filed.

Domestic Violence – 4500blk W Dean Rd

A 32 year old male resident reported an altercation with his girlfriend, a 24 year old female resident, who was refusing to leave the apartment. The male was arrested for Domestic Violence-Disorderly Conduct. The female was arrested for an outstanding warrant with the Greendale Police Department. Both subjects were conveyed to the station and booked. The male was released after posting bail and the female was turned over to the Greendale Police Department for the warrant. The Domestic Violence case will be reviewed by the Milwaukee County District Attorney's Office and a report was filed.

Family Trouble – 8000blk N 54th St

Report of family trouble at a residence. Officers made contact with a 19 year old female resident, a 48 year old female resident, and a 43 year old female resident. All three subjects stated that there had been a verbal argument only and nothing physical had taken place. The 19 year old called the police to keep the situation from escalating. The 48 year old and 43 year old agreed to stay at motel for the night to let things cool down. This incident did not meet the criteria for a Domestic Violence incident.
