Noteworthy Calls for the Day

Family Trouble – 4200blk W Hawthorne Trace Rd

An unidentified caller reported that a female subject was banging on an apartment door and yelling. Officers made contact with a 19 year old Milwaukee female, who was trying to pick up her child from the child's father, a 19 year old male resident, as agreed upon. The male lives at the apartment and he was not answering the door. Neither party had a court-ordered custody agreement. An officer made contact with the male, who advised he would bring their child to the female's residence in Milwaukee in the morning. The female agreed to this and left the area.
