Family Trouble – 8700blk N 60th St

An officer conducted a traffic stop. The driver, a 17 year old male resident, stated that he was upset because he just had an argument with his mother, a 38 year old female resident, who bit his finger. The male's finger was not injured. An officer made contact with the female, who admitted to biting her son. She advised that she did it because he was shaking his finger in her face while arguing about unloading the dishwasher too loudly. She stated that she was not trying to injure him. The female was counseled about her actions and a crime could not be substantiated.

Retail Theft - BP

BP reported a gas drive off. The business advised that a female subject pumped gas and paid for cigarettes and coffee, but not the \$28.23 for gas. An officer was able to determine the identity of the vehicle owner and made contact with a 53 year old Fox Point female.
