Motor Vehicle Theft – Audi Northshore

Audi Northshore reported that a vehicle was possibly stolen. It was determined that the vehicle, an Audi Q5 SUV, may still be loaned out to a customer. The business will follow up with the customer before calling police back and having the vehicle entered as stolen.

Theft – 8100blk N 61st St

An 84 year old female resident reported that someone may have attempted to remove her muffler from her vehicle overnight. The female stated that when she went outside she noticed that part of her muffler was lying on the ground, underneath her vehicle. It was determined that rust was the cause for the muffler breaking and no crime could be substantiated.

Request for Police – 4100blk W Schroeder Dr

A 14 year old male resident reported that he used his mother's credit card without permission. The juvenile called to admit to his crime because his mother told him the police would come to their house. Officers made contact with the 14 year old's mother and adult brother. His brother advised that they would handle the matter as a family. They never intended to make a complaint to police and only wanted to scare the juvenile.
