Noteworthy Calls for the Day

Juvenile Trouble – Brown Deer Elementary School

Recovered Stolen Vehicle – 9000blk Green Bay Rd

An officer reported being out with an occupied vehicle that was listed as stolen from the city of Milwaukee. After a brief foot pursuit, a 17 year old Milwaukee male was arrested for Operating a Motor Vehicle without Owner's Consent, Resisting Arrest, Receiving Stolen Property, and Retail Theft. The male was conveyed to the station and booked. The case will be reviewed by the Milwaukee County District Attorney's Office. The male was turned over to the Milwaukee Police Department, as he was wanted for numerous crimes in Milwaukee. A report was filed.

A 44 year old male resident reported that a suspicious white Acura was parked in front of his house. He believes it may be due to a Craigslist scam he fell victim to, which he reported to the FBI. Officers checked that area, but were unable to locate the vehicle.

Vehicle Crash – Wendy's

Disorderly Conduct - YMCA

Entry to Vehicle – 8200blk 46th St

A 26 year old female resident and 29 year old Milwaukee male reported that both of their unlocked vehicles were rummaged through by two unknown male juveniles. One suspect stole a bag of candy and both fled on foot from the scene. The 29 year old advised that he caught one of the juveniles in the 4500blk W. Dean Rd. and, after a minor scuffle, obtained the property back. Neither suspect was on scene upon officer's arrival. A report was filed.

Pursuit – Green Bay Rd/Brown Deer Rd

An officer attempted to stop a white Dodge Stratus for traveling 80 mph in the 7700blk of N. Teutonia Ave. The vehicle did not stop and ran the red traffic light at W. Bradley Rd. An officer pursued the vehicle. As the suspect vehicle approached the 3800blk W. Brown Deer Rd., the driver extinguished all the running lights on the vehicle. The officer terminated the pursuit as the vehicle continued eastbound on W. Brown Deer Rd. The vehicle was later located by the Bayside Police Department, operating at a high rate of speed without headlights, as it crashed on the off ramp of W. Brown Deer Rd. to northbound I-43. The Bayside Police Department arrested three occupants that fled from the vehicle after a short foot pursuit. The suspect vehicle was then discovered to have been reported stolen through the Milwaukee Police Department. The driver, a 15 year old Milwaukee male, was cited for Speeding and Red Traffic Light Violation. He was also charged with Knowingly Fleeing an Officer. The male will be charged by Bayside Police for Operating a Vehicle without Owner's Consent. He was then turned over to the Milwaukee Police Department, as he was wanted for numerous crimes in the city of Milwaukee. A report was filed.
