Noteworthy Calls for the Day

Noise Complaint – 4600blk W Tower Ave

Report of loud music coming from a vehicle in the area. Officers made contact with a 42 year old female resident, who was talking with a subject in a vehicle in her driveway. The female had turned the music down prior to the arrival of officers, but was made aware of the complaint.

Controlled Substance – Brown Deer Middle/High School

Brown Deer Middle/High School reported that three students were smoking marijuana in the parking lot. Three 14 year old male residents were arrested for Possession of THC and Possession of Drug Paraphernalia. They were conveyed to the station, booked, cited, and released to a parent. A report was filed.

Disorderly Conduct/Warrant – TAPCO

TAPCO reported that a terminated employee was causing a disturbance. The business requested that the subject be advised that he is no longer welcome on the property. Officers made contact with a 30 year old Milwaukee male. It was determined that the male had a warrant through the West Allis Police Department. The male was arrested and conveyed to the station. He was booked and released after posting bond. A report was filed.
