### **Noteworthy Calls for the Day**

#### **Traffic Offense – 9500blk N Green Bay Rd**

#### **Welfare Check – 4500blk W Dean Rd**

Brown Deer Middle/High School requested that officers check the welfare of a student that has not been to school since November 1<sup>st</sup>. Officers made contact with a 31 year old female resident and her 13 year old daughter. The two were involved in a verbal argument regarding the 13 year old refusing to go to school. The juvenile agreed to go to school without incident and was given a ride there.

#### **Theft – 8300blk N Grandview Dr**

A 29 year old male resident reported that packages were delivered to his residence and left on his front porch. He found the packages ripped open with items stolen. A report was filed.

#### **Theft – Brown Deer Middle/High School**

### **Retail Theft – Family Dollar**

Family Dollar reported that multiple subjects were inside the store and they believe the subjects were going to walk out with items. A 25 year old Milwaukee female was arrested in the parking lot for carrying out several items without paying. She was cited on scene and released. A report was filed.

### **Recklessly Endangering Safety - Walmart**

Report of a fight at Walmart where a subject brandished a knife. It was determined that a 23 year old Milwaukee female and a 28 year old Milwaukee female became involved in a physical altercation near Customer Service. During the altercation the 28 year old brandished a kitchen knife and attempted to stab the 23 year old several times. The 28 year old was arrested for 1<sup>st</sup> Degree Recklessly Endangering Safety-While Armed. She was conveyed to the station, booked, and transported to the Milwaukee County Jail. The case will be reviewed by the Milwaukee County District Attorney's Office and a report was filed.

### **Disturbance – Courtyard by Marriott**

Courtyard by Marriott reported that a female subject was being loud and causing a disturbance in the lobby. The female was not a guest at the hotel and they wanted her to leave. Officers made contact with a 51 year old Shorewood female, who was using the hotel's internet. She confirmed that she was not a guest and agreed to leave for the night.
