
Chief's Report

The Department participated in the Department of Transportation's Drive Sober or Get Pulled Over campaign. The results are listed below:




2014/2015 Year to Date Calls for Service




2014/2015 Year to Date Enforcement Action (arrests, citations & warnings)



Reported Crime Comparison September 2014/2015




Thefts – Includes Retail Thefts which account for approximately 45% of the total theft complaints.


North Shore Reported Incidents by Jurisdiction

The Department has one Investigator that also serves as a School Liaison Officers (SLO). The above graph depicts the percentage of time the SLO's spend performing the various duties assigned to them.

SLO Presence – Time the officers were physically present in the school (includes time instructing DARE).

School Related – Time spent on school related investigations/reports where the officer was not physically present at the school.
