



CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

PROJECT: Badger Meter River Park (SE Quadrant of W. Brown Deer Road/STH 100 & N. Kildeer Court)

Project Description:

The new Badger Meter River Park project is on-going. The new park is located in the SE quadrant of N. Kildeer Court & W. Brown Deer Road/STH 100. The contractor, All-Ways Contractors, Inc. continues with general site grading and utility installation. The new park includes a small parking lot and several walking paths. One of the site amenities is a new kayak launch which will be ADA accessible. The parking lot also features stormwater management devices in the form of porous asphalt and a center bioretention area. Funding for the project totaling \$25,209 was provided by MMSD. It is expected that the park will be completed around mid-September. Stay tuned for a ribbon cutting and grand opening information!

Completed Work To-Date:

- The contractor, All-Ways Contractors, Inc., has completed the stone base for the new paths and parking lot within the park boundary.
- The contractor has also completed all of the new underground piping for the new stormwater management facility (i.e. bioretention device).
- General site grading and topsoil removal/stockpiling have been completed.

Current Work In-Progress:

- All-Ways Contractors is installing the new park roadway connection to N. Kildeer Court.
- A new culvert pipe is being installed adjacent to N. Kildeer Court
- Lemberg Electric is installing a new park “identification” sign along W. Brown Deer Road/STH 100 at about the mid-point of the park property.
- The contractor is spreading all of the salvaged topsoil in the site preparing the site for restoration (i.e. tree/shrub planting and seeding).
- Asphalt path and parking lot paving is expected to occur the week of August 31st into the week of September 7th.
- The new kayak launch is scheduled for installation the week of September 7th.
