

The CDC recommends HIV testing for everyone at least once as part of routine health care, and for high-risk groups more often. Have you been tested? June is National HIV awareness month. More than 1 million people are living with HIV (human immunodeficiency virus) in the US, but 1 in 5 don't know they are infected. It's easy to get tested. ## **CAUTION...FRESH PAINT**



The annual pavement marking project is currently underway. The Village contracts with Crowley Construction Corporation to repaint all of the faded roadway pavement markings. Yellow centerline marking has been completed, and the hand painting for stop bars, crosswalks, words & symbols,

along with the white edge line painting will continue over the next two weeks during the overnight hours so as not to disrupt traffic.

## **DID YOU HEAR...?**

- ⇒ The seasonal flushing of the water system has been delayed this year due to the supply issues from Milwaukee. An abbreviated version of the "Big Flush", to help clear debris, etc. out of the system, will focus on areas of the Village that historically needed flushing. More information on the timeline will be coming.
- ⇒ A pre-construction meeting for the W Dean Road reconstruction project (between N Teutonia & N 55<sup>th</sup> St) was held this week. Construction is expected to start August 1st. The project includes pavement replacement & re-ditching, along with new sidewalk. The sidewalk work is funded through WisDOT's Safe Routes to School program.
- ⇒ The Eat & Greet in the Street at the Original Village was a huge success! The event was well attended and drew both young and old to the neighborhood. Many participants felt the event should become an annual affair.
