**Village Park Permits are now being sold for the 2015 picnic season that runs from May 1st – September 30th.**

Facilities include a shelter area, grill, volleyball court, horseshoe court and children's play area. Park Permit fees must be paid in full at the time the reservation is filled. Pond Admission Fees will be charged in addition to the Permit Fee and will be assessed the day of the event. A Clean-Up Deposit Fee will also be charged the day of the event and will be returned if the shelter and park area are left in good condition.

## Department of Public Works

**GENERAL:** The Director attended the monthly Technical Advisory Team (TAT) meeting at MMSD. Topics of discussion included "green infrastructure" planning efforts and a presentation made by an outside consultant describing the benefits of sustainable turf practices. Updates were also given from communities regarding their private property inflow & infiltration elimination efforts.

The Director attended the quarterly North Shore shared services meeting in the Village of Fox Point. Every three months the Villages of Bayside, Brown Deer, Fox Point, River Hills, Shorewood, Whitefish Bay, and the City of Glendale meet to discuss Department of Public Works operations. This quarter's meeting included a presentation by the WDNR as it relates to the North Shore Group's stormwater permit and assistance with ordinance revisions. Other topics of discussion pertained to winter operations, joint equipment purchases, and 2015 capital projects.



**STREETS & TRAFFIC:** The Board approved the new "no parking" signs along the west side of W. Dean Road adjacent to the Brooklane Apts. between N. Teutonia Avenue and N. Meadowside Court on Monday, January 19th. DPW crews installed the new signage on Tuesday, January 20th. Orange flags have been attached to each new sign designating the change in parking condition. The parking restriction was deemed necessary to avoid conflicts with passing vehicles in the adjacent travel lane and to also assist winter operations with snow clearing efforts.

Staff met with nurses and health aids from Shorewood Public Schools about **Personal Protective Equipment** and how to don (put on) and doff (take off) appropriately.
