## North Shore Health Department

North Shore Health Department co-hosted a health insurance education event with Columbia St. Mary's Community Outreach, Milwaukee Enrollment Network and Covering Kids and Families Wisconsin. Options for health insurance coverage, including options under the Affordable Care Act were presented.

## Department of Public Works

**GENERAL:** Bids were received for the W. Bradley Road reconstruction project. The apparent low bidder for the work is Vinton Construction Company of Manitowoc, WI. The project limits are between N. 51st Street & N. Sherman Blvd/CTH G. The project will replace the deteriorating concrete pavement and remove the center two-way-left-turn lane. A new bio-retention median will be installed along with new storm sewer infrastructure, concrete curb & gutter, and asphalt pavement. Also as part of the project the N. 50th drainage-way will be naturalized. The expected start date is April 1st with a completion date in July.

The Director attended a pre-construction conference for the new Lighthouse Senior Living Center project which is located on the west side of N. 60th Street immediately north of W. Brown Deer Road adjacent to (west) the Beaver Creek condos. The project is currently underway as of this week after all approvals were granted. The completion date is March of 2016 (14-month duration).



**SANITARY SEWER:** The Village has contracted with Visu-Sewer to assist with cleaning a 12-inch sanitary sewer main running in N. 55th Street and W. Beaver Creek Parkway adjacent to Signicast Corporation. A large amount of debris/deposits has been found within this segment of sewer after routine maintenance investigations. The Village is working with Signicast and MMSD on a solution to hopefully prevent future debris/deposit build-up.



**STREETS & TRAFFIC:** The DPW Operations Supervisor ordered new "entry way" signage for each of the ten (10) gateway roadways entering the Village. The new "entry way" signs include the updated overnight parking restriction information. The Village Board recently adopted new overnight parking rules which restrict on-street parking between the hours of 2am and 6am. The change now mirrors ordinances in each of the other north shore communities and creates an easier enforcement effort by the Police Department. DPW crews recently removed the old signage and will utilize the existing posts when mounting the new signs.
