**PLACE OF OCCURANCE:** Village of Brown Deer

### **DETAILS:**

In September of 2015 our department responded to a report of a retail theft where a female suspect had stolen clothing, left the store and fled the scene at a high rate of speed. The suspect ran a red light, striking a second vehicle in the rear, causing major damage to both vehicles. After the crash, the suspect drove away from the crash scene, abandoned her vehicle and then fled on foot.

The suspect was identified as 32 year old Ebony Channel Wright from Milwaukee. The Milwaukee County District Attorney's Office reviewed charges filed against Wright and found probable cause to issue an arrest warrant for the following charges:

Misdemeanor: Retail Theft

Felony: Second Degree Recklessly Endangering Safety

Felony: Vehicle Operator Flee/Elude Traffic Officer Resulting in Bodily Harm

After receiving an anonymous tip, our department requested the Cincinnati Ohio Police Department's assistance in locating Ebony Wright. The Cincinnati Ohio Police Department's Fugitive Apprehension Unit arrested Wright at a family member's house on Wednesday, January 27, 2016. She is currently in custody awaiting extradition to Wisconsin.

She is charged under Milwaukee County Case #15CF4329.
