DETAILS:

On Thursday, 9/29/16, at approximately 4:25 PM, Brown Deer Officers were dispatched to the report of two dogs attacking children in a front yard in the area of North 48th Street and West Dean Road. Upon officers' arrival, they observed two dogs attacking a juvenile female in the front yard of the home. To protect further injury to the victim and other children in the area, an officer shot the primary dog with his firearm. Upon doing so, the other dog turned and attempted to attack the officer, but was then also shot.

Both girls are 14 years old and received serious, but non-life threatening injuries. They were treated on the scene by North Shore Fire Department and transported to local hospitals.

Both dogs were adult aged Pitbull and lived in the home with one of the victims. Milwaukee Area Domestic Animal Control Center (MADACC) was contacted and responded to the scene. One dog died on scene and the other was turned over to them, at the request of the owner, to be euthanized.

This incident is still under investigation and no further information is available at this time.
