**TYPE OF CASE:** Personal Injury Crash – 2 Vehicles

**INJURIES:** One Fatality, two others injured

**PLACE OF OCCURANCE:** 6000 Block West Brown Deer Road

### **DETAILS:**

On Saturday, 2-13-16, at approximately 11:59 PM, Brown Deer Police responded to a report of a one car Property Damage Crash in the 6000 block of West Brown Deer Road.

Upon arrival, officers found that two vehicles were involved in a serious injury crash. It was determined that the driver of the striking vehicle was traveling northbound on North 60<sup>th</sup> Street and went through a red light, striking a SUV traveling eastbound on West Brown Deer Road. The driver of the SUV, a 25 year old female from Hustisford, was ejected from the car and was pronounced deceased at the scene. Her passenger suffered non-life threatening injuries and was transported by NSFD to a local hospital.

The driver of the striking auto, a 25 year old male from Milwaukee also suffered non-life threatening injuries and was transported by NSFD to a local hospital. It is believed that the driver of the striking vehicle was impaired. Charges will be referred to the Milwaukee County District Attorney's Office on Tuesday.

A portion of West Brown Deer Road was shut down for investigation purposes but has been re-opened. We are continuing our investigation with the assistance of the Wisconsin State Patrol.

The driver of the SUV has been identified as 25 year old Lauren A. Unertl of Hustisford. She was pronounced deceased at the scene.

The passenger in her vehicle is identified as 31 year old Edgar I. Barbosa of Hartford. He was transported to a local hospital with non-life threatening injuries.

The other driver's name is not being released pending charges being filed by the Milwaukee County District Attorney's Office.

**The driver has been identified as 25 year old Brandyn K. Corbins from the City of Milwaukee. He has been charged by the Milwaukee County District Attorney's Office with Homicide by Intoxicated Use of a Vehicle, Homicide by Intoxicated Use of a Vehicle with a Prohibited Alcohol Concentration, Injury by Intoxicated Use of a Vehicle (Great Bodily Harm) and Injury by Intoxicated use of a vehicle (Great Bodily Harm – Prohibited Alcohol Concentration).**

**Corbins is currently incarcerated at the Milwaukee County Jail.**
