TYPE OF CASE: Personal Injury Crash – 2 Vehicles

INJURIES: One Fatality, two others injured

PLACE OF OCCURANCE: 6000 Block West Brown Deer Road

DETAILS:

On Saturday, 2-13-16, at approximately 11:59 PM, Brown Deer Police responded to a report of a one car Property Damage Crash in the 6000 block of West Brown Deer Road.

Upon arrival, officers found that two vehicles were involved in a serious injury crash. It was determined that the driver of the striking vehicle was traveling northbound on North 60th Street and went through a red light, striking a SUV traveling eastbound on West Brown Deer Road. The driver of the SUV, a 25 year old female from Hustisford, was ejected from the car and was pronounced deceased at the scene. Her passenger suffered non-life threatening injuries and was transported by NSFD to a local hospital.

The driver of the striking auto, a 25 year old male from Milwaukee also suffered non-life threatening injuries and was transported by NSFD to a local hospital. It is believed that the driver of the striking vehicle was impaired. Charges will be referred to the Milwaukee County District Attorney's Office on Tuesday.

A portion of West Brown Deer Road was shut down for investigation purposes but has been re-opened. We are continuing our investigation with the assistance of the Wisconsin State Patrol.
