DATE AND TIME: February 25, 2016 9:29 PM **CASE NO:** 16-1887

TYPE OF CASE: Single Vehicle Crash

INJURIES: One Fatality, two others injured

PLACE OF OCCURANCE: 8000 block North Sherman Boulevard

DETAILS:

On Thursday, 2/25/16, at approximately 9:29 PM, Brown Deer Police Department and the North Shore Fire Department responded to a report of a single vehicle rollover crash on North Sherman Boulevard and North Teutonia Avenue.

Upon arrival, officers found a black 2006 Pontiac 4-door on its side in the roadway. The adult driver and two minor passengers were already out of the vehicle. The 35 year old driver from Milwaukee was transported to a local hospital by NSFD with non-life threatening injuries. The two children were also transported to a local hospital, where one was pronounced dead. The other child suffered non-life threatening injuries.

Preliminary investigation indicates that alcohol and speed were likely contributing factors to the crash. The Wisconsin State Patrol responded to assist with the investigation, which continues at this time. Charges are expected to be referred to the Milwaukee County District Attorney's Office early next week.

The adult driver has been identified as 35 year old Marcus D. Lee from the City of Milwaukee. He has been charged by the Milwaukee County District Attorney's Office with Knowingly Operate Motor Vehicle While Suspended – Causing Death. Additional charges are under review by the Milwaukee County District Attorney's Office.

Lee is currently incarcerated at the Milwaukee County Jail.
