**DETAILS:**

Today, at approximately 4:55 P.M., two Brown Deer Police Officers were conducting a traffic enforcement detail in the 8600 block of N. 60<sup>th</sup> Street when a Milwaukee County Transit Bus stopped by them advising of an unruly patron on the bus. As the officers attempted to remove the patron an altercation ensued resulting in both officers being injured and the patron being shot. All three were transported to local hospitals by the North Shore Fire Department.

The officers involved have since been treated and released. They have been placed on administrative leave per agency protocol.

The suspect is currently in custody and being treated at a local hospital.

Per Milwaukee County Protocol and Wisconsin Act 348, the Milwaukee Police Department is conducting the investigation.

There are no additional suspects being sought.
