**DETAILS:**

Today, at approximately 8:50 A.M., a Brown Deer Police Officer attempted a traffic stop on a vehicle which was traveling at a high rate of speed through the Village. The vehicle, occupied by three persons, failed to stop and fled the scene. After a short pursuit, the front driver's side tire fell off the vehicle and three juveniles were arrested in the 6300blk of W. Good Hope Road. The vehicle had been stolen in the City of Milwaukee but had not been reported yet by the owner, a rental company. Arrested were a 14 year old female, a 17 year old male and a 14 year old female.

All three subjects were taken to the station for booking. Charges of Operating Without Owner's Consent, Fleeing, Joy Riding and Recklessly Endangering Safety will be referred to the Milwaukee County District Attorney's Office or the Milwaukee County Children's Center. Several municipal citations were also issued.
