

BEAUTIFICATION/FORESTRY: The Director and Operations Supervisor met with a representative from Fox Services Inc. who is the Village's contractor for turf maintenance. The purpose of the meeting was to review the contract scope of services for all right-of-way turf management along with planter bed weeding, trimming, and maintenance services.


The Director submitted the annual Urban Forestry Grant final report for the 2014 activities. The Village received a grant (\$25,000) from the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources (WDNR) for Emerald Ash Borer (EAB) chemical treatments. The final report is submitted to the WDNR detailing the expenditures prior to grant repayment.

STREETS & TRAFFIC: DPW crews are repairing and re-installing damaged regulatory & warning signs throughout the Village from winter operations activities. Crews are also installing new "no-parking" signs along the east side of N. 55th Street between W. Brown Deer Road and W. Beaver Creek Parkway as per the Village's no parking ordinance. Crews are working on installing crosswalk signage on W. Dean Road at the new perpendicular crosswalks which were marked as part of the W. Dean Road Safe Routes to School (SRTS) project last fall.

As a reminder, the new overnight parking restrictions went into effect on January 19th, 2015 when the Board approved an ordinance change. No on-street parking is allowed between the hours of 2:00am and 6:00am per Village ordinance unless the vehicle has been called-in to the Police Dept. 
Children's Movie Night: Thursday, April 23rd "Penguins of Madagascar"

- Staff attended Emergency Mass Care Workgroup at Milwaukee County Sheriff's Academy. This workgroup works towards having plans in place in case of an emergency.



- North Shore Health Department staff attended the Batzner Pest Management Seminar. The seminar's focus was on treatment and control of pests such as bed bugs, rats, mice and cockroaches in public and private buildings or homes. Information on basic pest inspections, best techniques and protocols was also provided.

- Staff attended an education program by Dr. Richard Feldman on "Options for Influenza Prevention: An Influenza Vaccine for Older Adults." Updated information and results from recent clinical trials were discussed on the high dose influenza vaccine for adults. The benefits and side effects of the alternative intradermal influenza vaccine were also discussed in this presentation.
