### COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DEPARTMENT

The Community Development Director & Director of Public Works met with the Southeastern Wisconsin Regional Planning Commission and the Milwaukee Metropolitan Sewerage District to discuss the Village's projected future land use and development patterns. The information gathered will be used by MMSD to help them plan their facilities and infrastructure needs for sewer capacity through the year 2050

The Community Development Director and Director of Public Works met with representatives of Milwaukee County and 1000 Friends of Wisconsin to discuss their review of the Village's code of ordinances and its ability to foster sustainable development. The initial critique of the Code suggests that the Village is well positioned to encourage sustainable initiatives. A final report will be prepared in the next couple of months by the 100 Friends group.


### **Upcoming week's activities for Kids, Teens & Families include:**
