





NORTH SHORE HEALTH DEPARTMENT

A public health nurse attended **Rabies Control training**. The course provided information on bite management, statutory requirements, epidemiology of rabies in humans and animals.

Two staff members attended a **Vaccine for Children (VFC)** workshop to learn about changes or requirements for the VFC program in order to keep it up to date. The workshop also included information on the Wisconsin Immunization Registry.

Weekly Health Tips

Keep liquid laundry packets out of children's reach and sight! More than 33,000 calls were made to poison centers for laundry packet incidents since 2012, that's one call an hour.

Children have required hospitalization due to difficulty breathing, severe eye burns and irritation, temporary vision loss, loss of consciousness and excessive vomiting.
