## **NORTH SHORE HEALTH DEPARTMENT**

### **Communicable Disease:**

The NSHD has been working with area schools to provide information on ways to prevent the spread of gastrointestinal illnesses. Noroviruses are the most common cause of GI illnesses and they are commonly transmitted from person to person or through environmental contamination. The main symptoms of these viruses are sudden onset of vomiting and diarrhea. Vomiting is more common in the young, and diarrhea more common in adults. GI viruses can persist in the environment and be resistant to most disinfectants. The CDC recommends a chlorine bleach solution of 1000-5000 ppm, which is 5 - 25 tablespoons of household bleach per gallon of water. Handwashing, when done correctly is the single most effective way to prevent the spread of GI viruses. There are four simple steps to keep hands clean:

- Wet hands with warm running water;
- Add soap, wash the front & back of hands, as well as between fingers & under nails;
- Rinse hands with running water;
- Dry hands with a clean towel. Use towel to turn off water & then launder or dispose of towel in proper receptacle.

### **Public Health Emergency Preparedness:**

The North Shore Health Department met with staff from the Milwaukee Health Department to discuss planning for a region-wide full-scale preparedness exercise happening in June 2016. The exercise will test our plans to dispense medications in the event of a public health emergency.
