Children's Summer Library Reading Program

For children 12 and under
May 25th through August 25th

Beginning May 25th, come to the Brown Deer Public Library and register for the "Libraries Rock!" 2018 Summer Library Reading Program. At registration you will receive a reading log to keep track of your summer reading.

You can complete finish the program one of two ways:

- (1) **Read-to-Me** – for those being read to
- Having someone else (Mom, Dad, Grandma, Grandpa, etc) read you 60 books
 - There are 2 levels to this program:
 - Level 1: read 30 books and you'll receive your prize pack of coupons and other fun stuff
 - Level 2: read 30 more books and you'll receive an entry for our Grand Prize Drawing
- (2) **Reader** – for those who are reading on their own
- Reading for a total of 20 hours
 - There are 2 levels for this program
 - Level 1: read for 10 hours and you'll receive your prize pack of coupons and other fun stuff
 - Level 2: read for 10 more hours and you'll receive an entry for our Grand Prize Drawing

There is a limit of 1 reading log per child for the summer.
