

# BDNW Meeting Minutes for Wednesday, November 15th, 2017.

The meeting was called to order by our President Dale Gass, at 7:00 p.m. in the court room of the Brown Deer Village Hall. Twenty-three members were in attendance.

The meeting began with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Dale Gass asked some interesting Brown Deer Trivia questions about village incorporation, history, parks, hotels, and police department crime statistics.

Alice Mueller gave a treasurer's report of \$845.76.

Dale Gass led a discussion on the following topics:

- We raised a total of \$440 so far on the sale of yard signs, wrist bands, and lapel pins.
- A check was presented to Officer Nick Andersen of the Brown Deer Police Department for \$220 (1/2 the proceeds from the sale of the above-mentioned items) to be used at their discretion.

- Reminder that we have additional items for sale to support our group and the police department. (American/LE Memorial Flag and K9 paw print lapel pins, and thin blue line wrist bands, all for \$4 each.)
- Meetings were held with the management and residents of River's Edge and Deer Run apartment/condominium complexes to discuss how BDNW could help them.
- Asked BDNW members to please keep an eye out for our River's Edge and Deer Run neighbors.
- Talked about neighborhood watch app's (like Next Door) and how social media can help.
- Elections were held for our four officer positions. The following were re-elected to 2-year terms: Dale Gass - President, Barry Godshaw - Vice President, and Alice Mueller - Treasurer.
- Donna Zimmer was newly elected to the position of secretary.
- Officer Nick Andersen was appointed to the position of director, to replace Officer Brad Caddock, and Jim Farmer was appointed to the position of director to replace Rosalie Uebelacker.
- Proposed a new meeting time of 6:30 p.m. instead of 7:00 p.m. to take up less of the evening. The majority of attendees were in favor of this proposal.
