Operating While Intoxicated – N Teutonia Ave/W Bradley Rd

At 1:04 AM an anonymous caller reported a crash at the roundabout. A 30 year old Sheboygan male was located in his disabled vehicle one block north. He admitted to consuming alcohol and was arrested for Operating While Intoxicated-2nd Offense, conveyed to the station, booked, and released to a sober, responsible adult. The case will be reviewed by the Milwaukee County District Attorney's Office and a report was filed.

Suspicious Activity – 7800blk N 45 St

At 3:26 AM a 39 year old male resident reported that a suspect wearing a white hoodie, coming from a silver SUV, attempted to enter his Toyota RAV4. The suspect was unable to enter the locked vehicle and no damage was discovered. Officers checked the area but were not able to locate the subject.

Vehicle Crash – W Brown Deer Rd/N Green Bay Rd

Report of a crash at 9:22 AM. A 37 year old Decatur, NE male was operating a semi-trailer when a 73 year old male resident struck one of the semi's tires with his front right bumper as he was making a left turn onto W Brown Deer Road. A crash report was filed.

Retail Theft - Walmart

At 1:11 PM Loss Prevention reported that a subject concealed items inside their purse. A 53 year old Milwaukee female was arrested, cited on scene, and released. A report was filed.

Controlled Substance – 8200blk N Teutonia Ave

At 3:46 PM an officer conducted a traffic stop on a vehicle for multiple traffic violations. When contact was made with the driver, a 21 year old Milwaukee male, the odor of marijuana was coming from the vehicle, and marijuana residue was observed in the center console area. A search of the vehicle produced two medium-sized bags and two small jars of marijuana and a loaded firearm that was inserted into a Micro Conversion Kit. The firearm was removed from the vehicle and kept for safekeeping due to the male admitting it was not his. He was arrested for Possession of THC, conveyed to the station, booked, cited and released. A report was filed.

Animal Complaint – 6100blk W County Line Rd

At 5:17 PM an anonymous caller reported that a dog was tied to a trailer with no food or water. Contact was made with a 35 year old male resident, who stated that he just put the dog outside. The dog had water and was not malnourished. The male was advised of the complaint.

Traffic Stop – 7900blk N Teutonia Ave

At 10:46 PM an officer conducted a traffic stop on a Volkswagen for no registration plates and a defective headlamp. When contact was made with the driver, a 37 year old Milwaukee male, the odor of marijuana was emanating from the vehicle. The male stated that he smoked marijuana in the vehicle in the morning, but there was no marijuana in the vehicle. A search of the vehicle was conducted and nothing of evidentiary value was located. The male was released.

Controlled Substance – 4900blk W Good Hope Rd

At 11:12 PM an officer conducted a traffic stop on a Nissan Altima for operating with no headlamps activated. Contact was made with both occupants, a 52 year old Milwaukee male and a 37 year old Milwaukee male. While making contact with the vehicle, marijuana shake was observed on the passenger side floor board and both subjects gave false names. The vehicle was searched and multiple drug paraphernalia items were recovered. Inside of the trunk eight catalytic converters, two buzz saws, a bolt cutter and two car jacks were observed. The subjects were arrested for Obstructing and Possession of Drug Paraphernalia. They were conveyed to the station, booked, cited, and released. An investigation is ongoing regarding the catalytic converters found and a report was filed.
