### **Calls for the Day**

#### **Controlled Substance – Brook Lane Apartments**

At 1:01 AM an officer observed an occupied vehicle. Upon making contact with the driver, a 21 year old Milwaukee male, marijuana was observed in plain view. A search of the vehicle revealed marijuana and drug paraphernalia. The male was arrested for Possession of THC and Drug Paraphernalia, cited on scene, and released. A report was filed.

#### **Shots Fired – 8200blk N Teutonia Ave**

At 6:56 AM an anonymous caller reported that they possibly heard two gun shots coming from the north ten minutes prior to calling. An officer was in the area on patrol and heard no gun shots. Area and extended surrounding areas were checked, with negative results.

### **Traffic Stop – 8500blk N Teutonia Ave**

### **Controlled Substance – 8500blk N 52 St**

At 11:49 PM an officer conducted a traffic stop on a white Kia Sorento for disregarding a stop sign. When contact was made with the driver, a 35 year old Milwaukee male, marijuana was observed in plain view. A search of the vehicle produced a firearm, multiple bags of marijuana, marijuana edibles, and digital scales. The male was arrested for Carrying a Concealed Weapon, Possession of THC, and Possession of Drug Paraphernalia. He was conveyed to the station, booked, cited, and released. The case will be reviewed by the Milwaukee County District Attorney's Office and a report was filed.
