Weapons Complaint – 4500blk W Good Hope Rd

An officer conducted a traffic stop for numerous traffic violations at 12:37 PM. Contact was made with driver, a 23 year old Milwaukee male, and the passenger, a 27 year old Milwaukee male. Officers observed a dime bag of marijuana in the 23 year old's waistband in plain view. A search of the vehicle produced a loaded firearm with an extended magazine underneath the driver seat. Additional marijuana and drug paraphernalia were also located inside the vehicle. The 23 year old was arrested for Carrying a Concealed Weapon, Possession of THC and Drug Paraphernalia. He was conveyed to the station, booked, and released. The case will be reviewed by the Milwaukee County District Attorney's Office and a report was filed.

Fatal Crash – 5100blk W Brown Deer Rd

Report of a crash involving a motorcycle and a semi-truck at 6:55 AM. The operator of the motorcycle was fatally injured as a result of the crash. The Medical Examiner's Office responded to the scene. The Wisconsin State Patrol also responded to assist with the crash investigation. This case remains under investigation by the Brown Deer Police Department and the Wisconsin State Patrol.

Vehicle Crash – W Floral Ln/N 65 St

Report of a crash at 7:02 AM. It was determined that a 28 year old female resident, driving a Nissan, crossed over the center of the road and struck a 65 year old Kenosha female's Nissan Versa. A report was filed.

Suspicious Activity – Bob's Discount Furniture

Report of a person living in a tent behind Pick 'N Save at 9:43 AM. The occupied tent was located in the wood line behind Bob's Discount Furniture. Contact made with a 32 year old male, who stated that he was homeless. He was advised that he was on private property and packed up his tent, leaving the area without incident.

At 5:34 PM an officer conducted a traffic stop on a Honda for tint violations. Contact was made with the driver, a 22 year old Milwaukee male. While making contact, an odor of marijuana was coming from the vehicle. The male was removed from the vehicle and failed to follow officers' orders. He resisted arrest, causing officers to sustain injuries from his resistive nature. Taser deployment was attempted, but was not effective. The male got back inside his vehicle and drove off the scene and fled in an unknown direction. A warrant was entered for the male and charges will be referred to the Milwaukee County District Attorney's Office for Fleeing and Elude Traffic Officer, Battery to Public Officers, Felony Bail Jumping, and Resisting/Obstructing an Officer. A report was filed.

At 9:03 PM a 20 year old female resident reported that she was involved in a verbal argument with her father, a 39 year old male. It was determined that there was an argument between the two over the female writing something on a chalkboard in the home. They agreed to separate for the night.
