Attempted Motor Vehicle Theft – 8600blk N 63 St

Vehicle Crash – W Bradley Rd/N Sherman Blvd

Report of a crash at 7:50 AM. A 34 year old Milwaukee female was travelling southbound on N. Sherman Blvd. at W. Bradley Rd. A 43 year old male resident was eastbound on W. Retail Theft – Walgreen’s
