Traffic Stop – 6100blk W Bradley Rd

At 8:59 PM an officer attempted a traffic stop on a Chevy Malibu for failure to follow an indicated turn and passing on the right shoulder on W. Bradley Rd. at N. 51 St. The vehicle continued at about the posted speed limit west on W. Bradley Rd., failing to pull over. After slow-rolling through the red light at N. 60 St. and W. Bradley Rd. the vehicle appeared to be coming to a stop by merging into the parking lane and slowing.
