Fight – Brown Deer Lanes

Retail Theft - Walmart

At 11:46 AM Loss Prevention reported that a male subject walked out of the store with three unpaid boxes of sharpies. A 26 year old Milwaukee male was arrested, cited on scene, and released. A report was filed.

Parking Complaint – 8600blk N 43 St

At 1:32 PM an anonymous caller reported that they are unable to get through on the street due to multiple WE Energies trucks parked on the wrong side of the roadway. Multiple WE Energies trucks are actively working along the large construction development site and the roadway was open for single vehicle passage. No action was taken.

Retail Theft - Walmart

At 4:16 PM Loss Prevention reported that a known Retail Theft suspect, a 27 year old Milwaukee male, was in the store. The male and a 22 year old Milwaukee female did not pay for merchandise. The female was arrested without incident, cited on scene, and released. The male fled on foot and after a foot pursuit he was arrested for a warrant with the Wisconsin Department of Corrections, Retail Theft, and Resisting/Obstructing an Officer. He was conveyed to the station, booked and transported to the Milwaukee Secure Detention Facility. A report was filed.
