Homicide – 4900blk W Spring Ln

Report of multiple shots fired inside a residence at 11:51 AM. The suspect fled from the residence on foot. Arriving officers attempted life saving measures on an adult male suffering from multiple gunshot wounds, while additional officers searched the area for the suspect. The suspect was not located but has been identified and is known to the victim. The victim male was later pronounced deceased at the scene. The investigation is ongoing and a report was filed.

Neighbor Trouble – 7700blk N 47 St

At 4:09 PM a female resident reported that her neighbor, a 74 year old male, was leaving her letters to fix his roof that was damaged by a tree from her yard falling on it. The female advised that the incident was noted on 10/16/21 with her insurance company, but the male continues to bother her about reimbursement for damages. Contact was made with the male, who was counseled about his behavior and was warned that a citation would be issued if he continued.
