Milwaukee County communities are served by the complete range of health facilities and health professionals offered by the County's 18 area hospitals and over 1,000 area clinics. Of special interest is the Milwaukee Regional Medical Center, a consortium of private, non-profit and governmental institutions. The North Shore Health Dept. is housed in the Village of Brown Deer Village Hall, and serves both the Village and neighboring North Shore communities.
