## CIRCULATION

Our collection is the third-largest in the county per capita. This means there are 19 items in our library for every Brown Deer resident. We ordered, processed and added 6,081 items for the collection this year.

Our biggest business is still in the loan of movies and printed reading material (print=66%, DVD=24%, other=7%). Books for kids are borrowed the most, making up 25% of our total lending.

## PROGRAMS

**NEW:** North Shore Reads, Movies for Grownups, Wii after school gaming

**ONGOING:** Family and kids movie nights, Lego Club, special guest performers, ebook help, drop in crafts, and family friendly activities

**Summer Reading:** Signed up 543 kids & 128 teens, adults read 1,424 books

**Storytime:** 300 books over 60 hours

## EBOOKS

Ebook use by Brown Deer resident library users swelled by 678% since we started offering them in 2010. We've increased our ebook budget by 330% during that time to try to keep up with demand. Even with those big numbers, ebook use makes up only 3% of our total lending!

We also realize that getting library ebooks and onto tablets and ereaders is cumbersome and confusing, so we started offering help. Librarians gave over 26 hours of one-to-one hands-on instruction during special ebook help appointments. Call us, we're happy to help you too!

## COMPUTERS AND TECHNOLOGY

1 in 5 questions asked of library staff is related to technology in the library: Faxing, copying, emailing, document formatting, job searching on the web, printing forms, accessing government services, online testing, you name it!
