
Village of Brown Deer was awarded the GFOA's Distinguished Budget Award for the 2014 Budget by the Government Finance Officers Association

Safety Tips for Your Holiday Barbecue

Fire in the grill, under hot dogs and burgers, is a welcome sight at the family cookout. But fire anywhere else can make your holiday barbecue memorable for all the wrong reasons.

- Propane and charcoal BBQ grills should only be used outdoors.
- The grill should be placed well away from the home, deck railings and out from under eaves and overhanging branches.
- Keep your grill clean by removing grease or fat buildup from the grills and in trays below the grill.
- Keep children and pets away from the grill area.
- Never leave your grill unattended.
- When you are using charcoal and finished grilling, let the coals completely cool before disposing in a metal container.
- **Propane grills:** Check the gas tank hose for leaks before using it for the first time each year. Apply a light soap and water solution to the hose. A propane leak will release bubbles. If your grill has a gas leak, by smell or the soapy bubble test, and there is no flame, turn off the gas tank and grill. If the leak stops, get the grill serviced by a professional before using it again. If the leak does not stop, call the fire department. If you smell gas while cooking, immediately get away from the grill and call the fire department. Do not move the grill.

SANITARY/STORM SEWER

The Sanitary Sewer Technician coordinated with Duke's Root Control to provide root foaming chemical applications throughout 4,000 LF of 8-inch sanitary sewer main. Problematic root-clogged sewer mains are identified each year. Root-foam chemical applications are used to control/stop tree roots from blocking flow within sanitary sewer mains which ultimately prevents the probability of basement back-ups.

North Shore Health Department



The North Shore Health Department received an award for public health improvement, and a change in the department status from a Level II to a Level III. (Level III is the highest level a Health Department can achieve in the State).

- When driving in neighborhoods and school zones, watch out for young people who may be distracted and not thinking about safety
- Slow down. Watch for children playing and congregating near school bus stops



- **The DPW is OVERFLOWING with MULCH!!!**




Recycling Center Hours (April thru Sept)
