

DPW/Public Works Department

ROADWAY RE-PAVING PROGRAM: DPW crews have **completed** replacing select driveway culverts and crews are continuing the re-ditching project throughout the W. Carolann Drive & W. Glenbrook Road neighborhoods.


Brown Deer Lawn Service is working on restoring all of the re-ditching areas with 6-inches of topsoil material. DPW crews will re-seed the ditch areas using hydro-seeding methods throughout the month of October.

The paving contractor, Payne & Dolan, completed paving the first lift of binder course asphalt 2-weeks ago on Friday, October 2nd. Poblocki Paving Corp. started completing the asphalt driveway approach paving on Monday, October 13th. Next the crew will complete driveway approach paving on W. Carolann Drive and W. Glenbrook Drive after the rainy weather subsides. It is expected that the final lift of roadway surface course asphalt will be completed within the next 2-weeks.
