## **DPW/Public Works Department**

DPW plow drivers are going through their respective plow routes trimming overhanging tree branches and delivering deficient mailbox notices. Mailboxes are the property of the home owner. ## **W. COUNTY LINE ROAD RECONSTRUCTION**

Baumhardt Sand & Gravel completed all of the manhole adjustments throughout the project corridor last week, week of October 13th. Payne & Dolan is expected to pave the asphalt driveway aprons/ approaches next week, week of October 27th. The final lift of asphalt (surface course) is expected to be paved on Saturday, November 1st and Monday, November 3rd. In the meantime the landscaping contractor will be on-site completing all of the ditch restoration and general site clean-up. The project substantial completion date has been shifted out to November 15th due to the contractor's schedule.

## **W. DEAN ROAD RECONSTRUCTION**

Crews started placing the 6" thick - 1-1/4" base aggregate dense material for the new concrete sidewalk on Monday, October 20th. Hand-placement of the spot concrete curb & gutter repair areas were poured on Tuesday, October 21st. The concrete sidewalk installation started on Wednesday October 22nd. Payne & Dolan will be on-site Friday, October 24th and Saturday, October 25th pulverizing the existing asphalt roadway. The week of October 27th, crews will start re-grading the roadway surface in preparation for asphalt re-paving. The estimated project completion date has shifted out to November 15th due to the contractor's work schedule.

**PARKS & RECREATION** DPW crews will be assisting the Park & Rec Dept. with the winterization of Fairy Chasm Park & the Village Pond.

**Halloween night is fast approaching! Here are a few tips for children to stay safe while having fun.**
