INJURIES: School Bus Passengers – Minor Injuries

PLACE OF OCCURRENCE: West Bradley Road at North 60th Street

DETAILS:

On January 22, 2013 at 7:21 AM, a Brown Deer Police Officer observed a disabled school bus on West Bradley Road at North 60th Street. Upon speaking with the school bus driver, the officer discovered the school bus had been involved in a hit and run accident. The striking vehicle was described as a red vehicle, possibly an older model Buick, which fled from the scene. The North Shore Fire Department responded as six students on the school bus complained of injuries. The students were treated by the North Shore Fire Department and transported to area hospitals with minor injuries.
