

Refuse Cart Use and Service Plan

Each single/two family dwelling unit shall be provided one 90+ gallon refuse container for service once per week under the Village's ordinances and the Refuse and Recycling Contract. This container shall be covered by the Village's general property tax or fee as established by the Village Board.

Additional refuse carts may be obtained from the Department of Public Works in accordance with the following schedule of fees. The schedule of fees shall be based upon the Refuse and Recycling Contract costs for the life of the contract.*

Senior Center.....	No Charge
Single Family Unit.....	\$174.00
Single Family Unit (5+ children).....	No Charge, Proof of family required**

Fees shall be billed to the property owner or occupant for payment. The additional cart(s) shall not be delivered until the fee has been paid. For renewal, the fee shall be paid within 30 days of the date of the billing. Failure to pay the renewal fee shall mean the removal of the additional cart(s). The fee will be prorated for not less than a 6 month period. Refunds shall not be given for cancellation prior to the end of the one year billing period.

Locations with two or more carts shall have the carts identified by the Department for the Village's contractor to service. Secondary carts that are not identified by the Department shall not be serviced by the Village's contractor.

* The above fees are based upon: Contract – averaged weekly collection fee, cart cost depreciated over a 10 year period, averaged disposal costs and historical refuse tonnage per residence plus adjustment for heavier business refuse. Fee includes a 15% administration fee for the program.

** The "Single Family Unit (5+ children)" assumes 2 parents are present and would be a family of 7 or more that may need an extra cart. The "children" requirement excludes a residence that could house 7+ adults (aunts, uncles, grandparents, 19+ yrs. age, etc.) that could have the ability of additional income. The Department will be using the top portion of a copy of the family's IRS1040 form that would show the dependents and relationship – all social security and income information blacked-out.
