

GENERAL: The Director attended the Village Board meeting on Monday, February 16th.

At the meeting the new **River Park Project** construction contract was approved and awarded to All Ways Contractors of Waukesha, WI.

The River Park project will create a new parking lot and access path to the Milwaukee River located in the Village owned parcel at the SE quadrant of W. Brown Deer Road & N. Kildeer Court.



SANITARY SEWER: The Director finished the design plans for the **N. 60th Street utility replacement project**. Plans are currently out for bid to prospective contractors.

Bids are due on Thursday, Feb. 26th at 10:00am.

The Sanitary Sewer Technician assisted with the design plan preparation ahead of the N. 60th Street sewer lateral replacement project. Field investigations were completed along with a review of the televising reports to insure information is presented accurately for bidding purposes.

Community Development Department

The Community Development Director has been working with Milwaukee County Transit to finalize routing and stop locations for a new east/west bus service in the Village. Route 276 will begin service in late March and run primarily along W. Brown Deer Road from Park Place Court to Green Bay Road and Schroeder Drive. The new route will connect with routes 12 and 76.

Recently submitted plans for a new retail development at the corner N. Deerwood Drive and N. Green Bay Road have been put on hold due to the loss of the prospective anchor tenant for the project. The plans were previously recommended for approval by the Plan Commission on February 10th.
